It was so nice to see so many residents enjoying the 'Memory Lane Entertainment' this week.

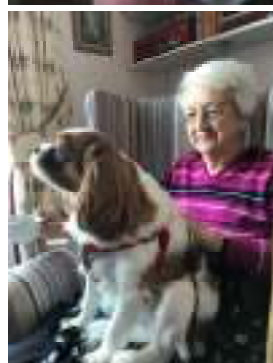
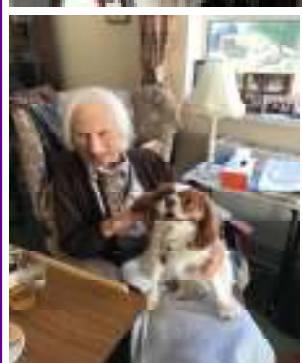
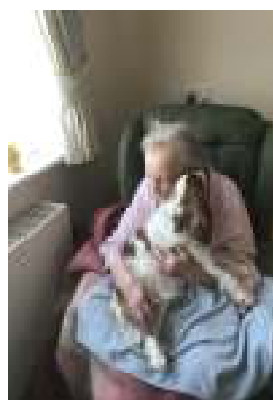
We look forward to having Steve return to Avenue House in the upcoming months.

We hope she will visit again soon.



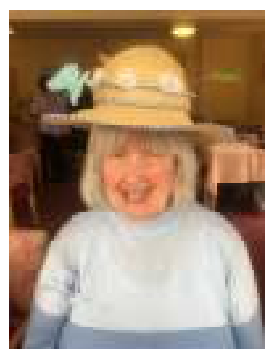
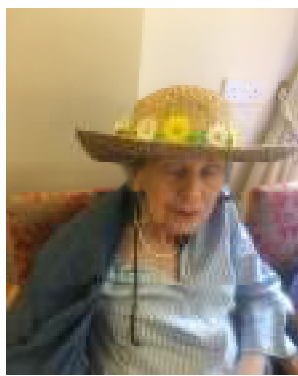
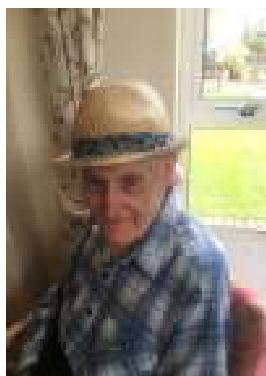
Easter Bonnet Parade
